# Safe Drug Disposal: Drug Take Back Options

This summer NSHD will be attending farmers markets and other community events to discuss harm reduction, safety, and prevention, including safe drug disposal.

Drug take back options are the best way to safely dispose of unused or expired medications. There are several kinds of drug take back options you can utilize. Before you dispose of your medications, make sure to remove personal information on labels and packaging.

### Permanent collection sites

There are various facilities and businesses registered with the U.S. DEA to collect unused or expired medications. These collection sites safely gather and dispose of your unused or expired medications, including those that contain controlled substances.

Find a collection site near you using this link or call the DEA Diversion Control Diversion Control Division Registration Call Center at 1-800-882-9539 for more information about collection sites. You can also search "drug disposal near me" or "medication disposal near me" on Google Maps to find a disposal sites near you. Please note, there are select medications with specific instructions to immediately flush down the toilet if a drug take back option is not readily available. The FDA's Flush List can be found here.

## Bags and packets for deactivation & disposal

Deterra Bags is another option to dispose of drugs and prevent drug misuse. Using a Deterra Bag protects the environment through safe and permanent disposal of unused prescriptions and over the counter medications. These bags deactivate drugs, pills, patches, liquids, creams, and films, making them unavailable for misuse.

We offer FREE Deterra Deactivation and Disposal Bags and FREE DisposeRX packets. Both bags and packets deactivate medications and are available by stopping by our community booths or at both of our offices (Brown Deer office: 4800 W Green Brook Dr., Shorewood office: 2010 E Shorewood Blvd.).
