September 14, 2022: Ovarian Cancer Awareness

September is Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month.

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), **ovarian cancer**:

- Is the second most common gynecologic cancer in the United States
- Causes more deaths than any other cancer of the female reproductive system
- Ranks fifth in cancer deaths among women.


The ovaries are small organs located on either side of the uterus that produce eggs and several hormones. Ovarian cancer occurs when malignant (cancerous) cells develop in, near, or on the outer layer of one or both ovaries.

According to the American Cancer Society:

- In 2022, it is estimated that 19,880 cases of ovarian cancer will be diagnosed
- An estimated 12,810 women will lose their lives to ovarian cancer this year
- The risk of a woman getting ovarian cancer is about 1 in 78 in her lifetime

It is important to pay attention to your body and know what feels normal for you. Contact your healthcare provider if you are concerned about any of the above signs and symptoms, risk factors, or to learn more. Also contact your healthcare provider to schedule a preventive care visit.

JYNNEOS vaccine is currently available for the following people:

- Known contacts who are identified by public health through case investigation, contact tracing, and risk exposure assessments.
- Presumed contacts who may meet the following criteria:
 - People who know that a sexual partner in the past 14 days was diagnosed with monkeypox.
 - People who attended an event or venue where there was known monkeypox exposure. Gay men, bisexual men, trans men and women, any men
 - who have sex with men, and gender non-conforming/non-binary people, who have had multiple sexual partners in the last 14 days.

• People considered to have an elevated risk of exposure to monkeypox in the future:

- Gay men, bisexual men, trans men and women, any men who have sex with men, and gender non-conforming/non-binary people who expect to have multiple or anonymous sex partners. This may include people living with HIV and people who take HIV pre-exposure. Clinical laboratory personnel who perform testing to diagnose orthopartyring.
- diagnose orthopoxiruses. Research laboratory workers who directly handle cultures or animals contaminated or infected with orthopoxiruses that infect humans.
- Certain health care providers working in sexual health clinics or other specialty settings directly caring for patients with sexually transmitted infections
