Wisconsin officially topped 200,000 cases of COVID-19 today. It took 7 ½ months to reach our first 100,000 cases, and only 36 days to reach our second. The antigen positives may be confirmed with a PCR test – if the PCR test is positive, they are added to the confirmed cases. If the PCR test is negative, they are no longer considered antigen positive.

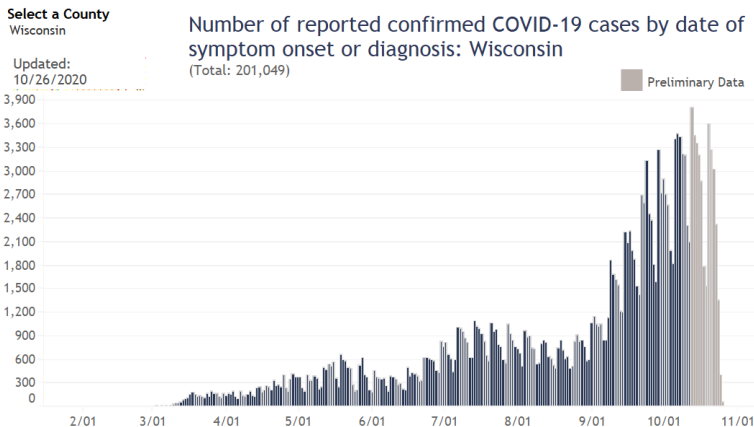
