

COVID-19 Cases to Date

North Shore (Bayside, Brown Deer, Fox Point, Glendale, River Hills, Shorewood & Whitefish Bay) - as of October 27th Changes from 10/26. This data is also available on our website.

1,700 Cumulative Confirmed Cases* (+29)

*Confirmed with PCR test.

295 active cases (+16)

1,383 recovered cases (+12)

22 deaths (+1)

45 Antigen Positives** (+2)

The antigen positives may be confirmed with a PCR test – if the PCR test is positive, they are added to the confirmed cases. If the PCR test is negative, they are no longer considered antigen positive.
