Today is World AIDS Day, a time for remembrance and

renewed commitment to end the HIV epidemic. People with HIV may have concerns and questions related to their risk of serious illness from COVID-19. At this time, we are still learning how COVID-19 affects people with HIV and it is believed that people with HIV who are on effective HIV treatment have the same risk for COVID-19 as people who do not have HIV.

The risk for people with HIV getting very sick is greatest in people with a low CD4 cell count, and people not on effective HIV treatment (antiretroviral therapy or ART).
