## COVID-19 VACCINE: WHO IS ELIGIBLE IN WISCONSIN?

### CURRENTLY ELIGIBLE GROUPS IN PRIORITY ORDER

- Frontline health care personnel
- Residents and staff in skilled nursing and long-term care facilities



- Police and fire personnel, correctional staff
- Age 65 and older



- Educators and child care
- People enrolled in Medicaid long-term care programs
- Some public facing essential workers
- Non-frontline essential health care personnel
- Staff and residents in congregate living facilities



### NEXT ELIGIBLE GROUPS

**MARCH 29**

People age 16 and older with certain medical conditions known to be associated with an increased risk of severe illness from COVID-19.

**MAY**

Everyone age 16 and older.

As of March 11, a total of 7,306 samples have been sequenced to identify variant strains. The B.1.1.7 variant has been identified 31 times, the B.1.351 variant one time, and the P.1. variant has not been identified.

*The antigen positives may be confirmed with a PCR test – if the PCR test is positive, they are added to the confirmed cases. If the PCR test is negative, they are no longer considered antigen positive.*
