**May 13, 2021. The Wisconsin Department of Health Services has expanded vaccine eligibility.**

Children ages 12-15 are now eligible for the PFIZER vaccine.

**The CDC has changed the guidelines for FULLY VACCINATED individuals.**

Individuals are considered FULLY vaccinated:

- 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines

OR

- 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine

**The CDC has stated that fully vaccinated people can resume activities without wearing a mask or physically distancing, except where required by federal, state, local, tribal, or territorial laws, rules, and regulations, including local business and workplace guidance.**
