Gating Criteria: To determine when to transition to the next phase, gating criteria will be monitored on the Milwaukee County Office of Emergency Management [Dashboard](#) under the "Key Indicators" tab. The gating criteria are updated every Monday and Thursday at 12 p.m. After 14 days of Phase B, the status of the gating criteria will be reevaluated to determine if it is safe to move forward. When all five of the criteria are green or yellow, the North Shore will prepare to move to the next phase.


