



## **NUMBER OF NEW COVID-19 TEST RESULTS** (POS OR NEG) RECEIVED BY DAY, AND % POSITIVE (3 DAY ROLLING AVERAGE)



This graph displays the total number of positive and negative test results received per day in the North Shore, the percent of test results that were positive (3 day rolling average), and a linear trendline of the percent positive for the last 14 days. A total of approximately 5,665 COVID-19 tests have been conducted in the North Shore as of 2:00 p.m. on June 26th. With a population of approximately 65,000 in the North Shore, this indicates that 8.7% of the North Shore population has been tested at this time.
