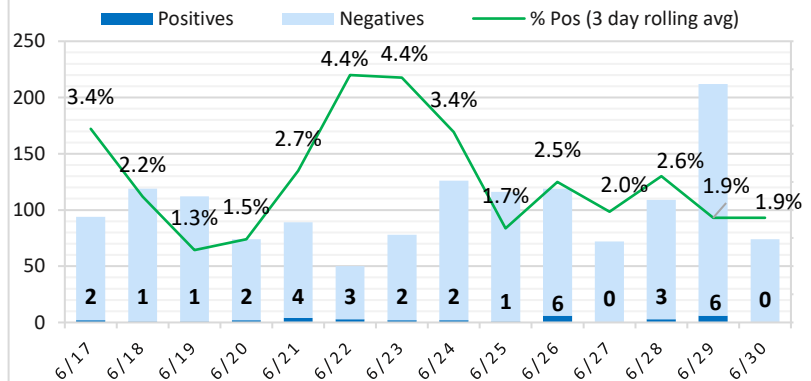

NUMBER OF NEW COVID-19 TEST RESULTS (POS OR NEG) RECEIVED BY DAY, AND % POSITIVE (3 DAY ROLLING AVERAGE)



**This graph displays the total number of positive and negative test results that were positive (3 day rolling average).** A total of approximately 6,242 COVID-19 tests have been conducted in the North Shore as of 2:00 p.m. on July 1<sup>st</sup>. With a population of approximately 65,000 in the North Shore, this indicates that 9.6% of the North Shore population has been tested at this time.
