Have you been waiting more than 5 days for your COVID-19 test results? Do you need a copy of your test results? Get your results by calling the Wisconsin COVID-19 Results Line at (866)419-6988. The COVID-19 Results Line is open Monday-Friday from 8am-6pm.

Once you call, you'll need to provide:

- The date of your test,
- The National Guard testing site you visited
- Your name, and
- Your date of birth.

In addition to getting your results over the phone, the Results Line can mail you your test results.

Please wait to call the Results Line until 5 days after your test. If you call before the 5-day mark, they cannot guarantee your results will be ready.

Milwaukee Mask Mandate: The Milwaukee Common Council voted to require face masks in indoor places in the City of Milwaukee, as well as in outdoor spaces within six feet of others.



Shorewood Mask Mandate:

Masks must be worn in indoor areas open to the public until January 20, 2021. The Village will be contacting establishments and community members if they are not

adhering to the mask requirement indoors. You can file a complaint with the Village through the Face Mask Complaint Form.


