

A total of approximately 13,000 COVID-19 tests have been conducted in the North Shore as of 2:00 p.m. on July 29<sup>th</sup>. With a population of approximately 65,000 in the North Shore, this indicates that 20.0% of the North Shore population has been tested at this time.

The above graph displays the percent of all tests that are positive by date received. We are still processing negative lab results, so the numbers are subject to change for the most recent days.


