A total of approximately 7,395 COVID-19 tests have been conducted in the North Shore as of 3:00 p.m. on July 9<sup>th</sup>. With a population of approximately 65,000 in the North Shore, this indicates that 11.4% of the North Shore population has been tested at this time.
