As fall religious holidays approach, it is important to keep in mind some tips to keep you, your family, and your community safe. Here are some tips for reducing COVID-19 transmission risk for faith-based communities.

**Lowest Risk:** Virtual Services

- Able to participate in services and support community remotely

**Moderate Risk:** Drive-up Services

- Hand-outs and single use items (communion, worship aids, bulletins, etc.) should be distributed through car windows
- Members handing out items should wear masks, wash hands, and practice social distancing otherwise
- Allows vulnerable members of community to participate
- Offer virtual service for vulnerable community members or space for those without cars (following outdoor service guidelines)

**Higher Risk:** Outdoor Services

- Remain at least 6 ft apart and wear a mask
- Avoid sharing any items (worship aids, bulletins, books, etc.)
- Avoid singing (aerosol droplets spread further than when just breathing or speaking, which increases risk of transmission)
- Avoid lining up for items, instead consider handing out single use items through car window
- Offer virtual service for vulnerable community members

**Highest Risk:** Indoor Services

- Stay at least 6 ft apart – tape or markings can be helpful reminders to distance properly
- Wear a mask and avoid sharing items
- Avoid singing (aerosol droplets spread further than when just breathing or speaking, which increases risk of transmission)
- Avoid lining up, consider handing out single use items upon entry
- Clean high touch areas (door handles, seats, etc.)
- Offer virtual service for vulnerable community members
