With Labor Day approaching, many Wisconsinites have travel plans lined up for the long weekend. COVID-19 is still spreading within our communities and Wisconsin DHS recommends canceling or postponing all travel, including travel within the state. However, if you must travel follow Wisconsin DHS guidelines and recommendations.

Travel Within Wisconsin:

- Travel between private homes is not recommended. Travel to seasonal homes or cabins raises the risk of you exposing others in the host community that you interact with at grocery stores, gas stations, and other public places.
- Several counties in Wisconsin have issued travel advisories for seasonal and second homeowners. If you must travel, check for area-specific safety updates and closures.
- **Bring everything you will need**, including: groceries, medications, and toiletries.
- If you do go out into the community, practice physical distancing, wear a face mask, and wash or sanitize hands frequently
- Limit groups you are traveling with to those that you live with; This reduces the number of interactions and reduces risk for spread or exposure

• If you need to stop for food, gas, or supplies: limit

interaction with employees to one traveler, wear cloth face covering, and wash your hands

Important: Do not travel if you or someone in your home is sick with symptoms of COVID-19

After you Return, check yourself for symptoms of COVID-19 for 14 days. You should check for symptoms even if you followed the recommendations above and call your doctor if you develop symptoms like fever, cough, and/or shortness of breath.
