



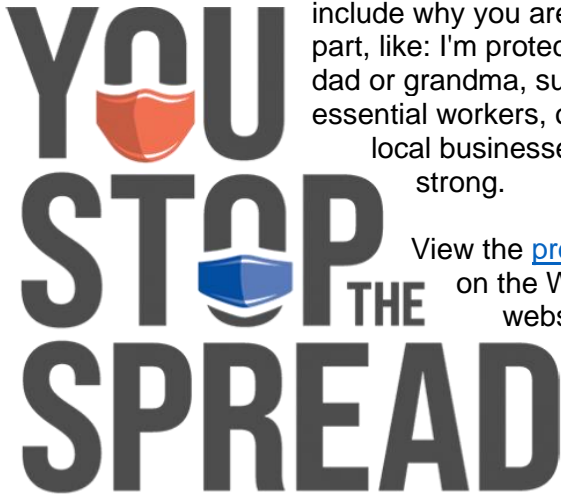
# North Shore Health Department Public Briefing
