Advocate Aurora Health is now offering expanded COVID-19 testing for their patients and community members who have COVID symptoms.

If you have ANY of these symptoms, you may need a test to see if you have COVID-19: cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, body or muscle aches, headache, fatigue, sore throat, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or recent loss of taste or smell.

- It is important that you contact us to register before coming to an Advocate Aurora COVID-19 Community Testing site as everyone needs an appointment before they can be tested.
