WHAT IS WEAVR?

WEAVR is a web-based online registration system for Wisconsin's health professional volunteers willing to serve in an emergency. WEAVR includes nurses and doctors of all kinds, as well as mental/behavioral health practitioners, EMTs, medical technicians, dentists, veterinarians, and scores of other specialists.



Signing up is easy. If you have 15 minutes, access to a computer and the internet, you can complete the online registration.

VOLUNTEER IN YOUR COMMUNITY

When you register, you are asked to select at least one organization to be affiliated with. To register as a volunteer with the North Shore Health Department, navigate under "Milwaukee County" and select "North Shore Health Dept" as the organization.

It will save time during registration if you have your professional license information, emergency contact information, and Social Security number with you.

WHO CAN REGISTER TO BE A VOLUNTEER THROUGH WEAVR?

WEAVR is open to active and retired health care professionals and also welcomes behavioral health and animal health professionals. Your credentials will be verified and background check completed by the WEAVR system.

DO I NEED A MEDICAL DEGREE OR LICENSE TO REGISTER WITH WEAVR?

No, there are many roles in an emergency that do not require a medical degree or license.

WHAT KINDS OF EMERGENCIES WOULD I BE CALLED TO HELP WITH?

A variety of public health emergencies could result in you being called to assist—such as a hazardous material spill, flood, tornado, need for mass dispensing of medications or vaccinations.

IF I RECEIVE A REQUEST TO VOLUNTEER THROUGH WEAVR, DO I HAVE TO VOLUNTEER?

If you are asked to respond in an emergency, you always have the option to say you are not able to. Messages are sent out via the WEAVR system when volunteers are needed. You are asked to respond to the requests with your availability.
